## **Vision Conference in Atlanta**

After Christmas I went to the Bridges Winter Conference, which was in Atlanta, this year. There were over 1,200 people there from from around the world, 30 of those being part of Bridges at ASU. In our group alone there were people from S. Korea, Rwanda, China, Iran, Japan, Liberia, Taiwan, India, and Brazil. We were in different tracks while we were there (tracks allow students to learn about Jesus in a cultural context that is meaningful for them). The staff had a variety of roles, but it was our campus times and our dance practices for our talent show dance that made the times together sweet and built community.

One of our Japanese students who became a Christian earlier last year, wanted to meet Japanese Christians at this conference and she was able to met both Japanese Christians and American Christians who had been missionaries in Japan for several years. She was encouraged as she asked them what it will look like for her to be a Christian in Japan and how she can start preparing for it now. I'm thankful for those God brought into her life who could tell her about specific things in ways I couldn't because I've never lived overseas in a place that wasn't open to Christianity.

Because the majority of international students (particularly the grad students) are guys, we need more: staff men, men from the community, and students (both American and internationals) to provide leadership in befriending, evangelizing, and discipleship. Currently, with me off campus seeking additional ministry partners full-time, there is only one staff man and just a few male volunteers ministering to the students.
