Family Story Group

Every-other-week this semester we have been meeting with a small student group to learn about and discuss an event of Jesus' life. These gatherings were for the non-Christians who are still interested in learning about Him.

We used a simplified version of each of the stories, as provided StoryRunners - a ministry which promotes the aural telling of Bible stories, for illiterate cultures. Some of the students would even agree to memorize the stories to tell the group. The last several meetings dealt with the events which lead up to Jesus' death.

Easter Program

In April our meeting night fell on Good Friday, and the program was promoted as a magic show and an explanation of the meaning of Easter. This was my once-a-semester opportunity to do a magic program for the group. I have a magical effect which illustrates what happened that first Easter morning, but in order to understand what happened then, one needs to know what happened on the proceeding two days. So, we asked one of our non-Christian students from India to tell the Good Friday story to the group - from memory - like we taught it the previous Friday in the small group. He was a bit nervous, but did a great job.

The Holy Spirit was moving. After I demonstrated the "what" of Easter, I explained the "why" - and gave an opportunity to respond to the love of Jesus by accepting His gift of dying in our place to pay the penalty for our sin. **Praise God for the five who indicated that they prayed with me to trust Jesus, and one who wanted to get more information.**
